BEQUEST GUIDE

A gift in your Will to a charity is more than a donation; it's a way to extend your values and make a lasting difference.

Here's how to include Outward Bound Australia in your Will:





1. Decide the Type of Bequest

You can choose to leave:

- A percentage of your estate (e.g. 5% or 10%)
- A specific sum of money
- A particular asset (e.g. property, shares, or other items of value)
- The residue of your estate (what's left after specific gifts and expenses)

Tip: Leaving a percentage (rather than a fixed amount) allows your gift to keep pace with inflation.

2. Use the Correct Wording

Share the following wording with your Solicitor or Will writer.

" I give to the Australian Outward Bound Foundation, 35 Naas Road Tharwa ACT 2620 (ABN 57 000 250 635) for its general purpose, {insert your gift: eg. 'The sum of \$10,000' OR '20% of my estate' OR 'The residue of my estate' OR 'Describe asset in as much detail as possible' free from all duties. The receipt of the Chief Executive Officer or other authorised officer of the Australian Outward Bound Foundation shall be full and sufficient discharge for my Executor(s).

3. Let Us Know (Optional but Appreciated)

If you've included Outward Bound Australia in your Will, we'd love to hear from you. This helps us:

- Acknowledge your generous decision
- Keep you connected to our mission
- Work with you to plan for the future impact of your gift.

4. Update Your Will as Needed

Review your Will every few years, or after major life changes, to make sure it still reflects your wishes.
